DID YOU KNOW?

The CARES Act, recently passed by Congress, provides a universal deduction for contributions of up to \$300 that are made in 2020, even for taxpayers who do not itemize. Additionally, for tax year 2020, Congress has lifted the existing cap on annual contributions for itemizers from 60% to 100% of Adjusted Gross Income (AGI).
